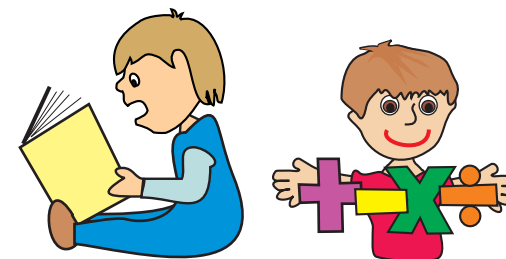

READING PROGRAMS

Reading groups of 4-6 children will meet once per week for 2 hours of intensive individualized instruction.

Ability grouping allows for reading materials and instruction to always be at the correct level for maximum success.

Instruction will include phonics, vocabulary, comprehension, inferential meaning, fictional reading, textbook reading, language arts skills, and more.

Reluctant readers thrive in this positive, success-based program. Many special strategies will be used to improve reading.

WRITING PROGRAMS

Writing and spelling groups will meet once per week for 2 hours of intensive individualized instruction.

Writing instruction will teach children to make use of graphic organizers, story boards, picture sentences, and other strategies to support writing. Strategies for punctuation, capitalization, and complex sentences will be taught.

Spelling Lessons

Each week writing groups will focus on different spelling patterns. Both regular and irregular spellings will be studied. Multiple strategies and modalities will be used to help improve spelling.

Elizabeth Willis holds a Ph.D. and is a retired professor from LSU. She is also a former teacher with expertise in upper elementary and middle school reading and writing.
